DECISION NOTICE

Application Type: Details To Comply (ESSO)

Proposal: Submission of details to comply with requirement 6 (construction environmental management plan) pursuant to Schedule 2 of the Southampton to London Pipeline Development Consent Order 2020 made 7 October 2020

Location: Esso Pipeline, Frimley Green Road, Frimley, Camberley, Surrey, GU16 7AJ

I write with reference to your submission of the above application and your e-mail of 6 August.

I am able to confirm that following consultation with the Council's Greenspaces team, Arboricultural Officer and Environmental Health team, the County Archaeologist, Natural England, Surrey Wildlife Trust, Chobham, West End and Windlesham Parish Councils, the Environment Agency, the Lead Local Flood Authority and Affinity Water, the submitted Construction Environmental Management Plan Revision no 2.0 June 2021 as updated by your e-mail of 6 August 2021 is acceptable for the purposes of requirement 6 and is approved.

In the interests of clarity and informing this decision Esso has confirmed/agreed to the following:

Esso will provide the Council with all pre-construction surveys.

Esso will provide the Council with details of compound surfacing once these construction details are known.

Esso will provide the Council with construction method statements as detailed under Commitment G40.

Esso will provide the Council with details of the control measures to protect wet heathland as detailed under Commitment G48.

Esso will translocate all reptiles found within the newt translocation area. It is noted that due to the presence of exclusion fencing when undertaking trapping and translocation programmes for any species it would be essential to translocate reptiles or other non target species that were encountered.

If surveys at St Catherine's SANG indicate that carrying capacity of the remaining habitat has the potential to be exceeded, Esso will commit to offsite translocation of reptiles to a site identified by the Council.

Esso will provide crossing points for badgers and will fence trenches. Esso will provide a means of escape for badgers. Esso acknowledges the potential health and safety issues associated with badgers

Esso will advise the Council when licence applications are made to Natural England and will provide copies of the licences approved by Natural England.

I hope this clarifies the current position and is of assistance.
