

Our work in Queen Elizabeth Park

Installation of the replacement pipeline in Queen Elizabeth Park will start in May 2022. The map below shows our working area within the park. Our works consist of two trenchless crossings into the park at either end and an open cut section through the park.

- We have closed the existing play area and closed Cabrol Road car park to install the compound.
- We have installed an alternative play area and it is now open for use.
- Public access into the park from Cabrol Road will be maintained but parking will be suspended during installation.
- From May, we will start the trenchless crossing TC017/18 which enters the park near Cabrol Road.
- Open cut installation and the trenchless crossing of Farnborough Road (TC019) in the park will likely take place from July to October 2022.
- The working area for the open cut section will be narrowed to a maximum width of 10m.
- Construction will not require any lopping or coppicing of the Fairy Tree.

Construction Overview

Throughout 2022, we're replacing our existing aviation fuel pipeline, which runs through Queen Elizabeth Park in Farnborough.

We have completed our pre-construction work in the park, including the temporary relocation of the park's play area and the installation of the temporary construction compound off Cabrol Road, to support the works being undertaken in the park.

From May we will begin trenchless installation of the pipeline, working in the park close to the Cabrol Road entrance. This will be followed by open-cut installation in July. We'll use narrow working and tried and tested techniques during installation to avoid damaging roots. During installation, the use of Cabrol Road car park will be suspended as will the southern footpath, but park access will be maintained from the north and south with parking available at the A325 entrance. Our work in the park is due to complete in the autumn.

As installation begins, you will see many large vehicles carrying out deliveries and supporting works. No one likes the noise and inconvenience caused by construction activities, so we'd like to apologise and thank you in advance for your patience when it comes to any disruption that we may cause. When installation is complete, we will reinstate the paths and vegetation on a like-for-like basis.
